


The Environmental Judge presides over 800-1,000 cases each month.

Jurisdiction of the Court

The Environmental Court has exclusive jurisdiction over criminal cases involving violations of the local housing, building, fire, zoning, health, waste collection, animal licensing, animal abuse, and pollution codes. The court also hears civil cases involving nuisance properties, local appeals, and landlord/tenant disputes.

The Environmental Division's jurisdiction encompasses all of Franklin County, including those portions of Columbus that lie outside of Franklin County.
