Parking and Motor Vehicles

Parking and motor vehicle issues become more significant during the warmer months, as people more frequently wash and park their cars in their yards, have parties needing additional parking space (with guests often parking on soft surfaces- like the yard), and some residents work on cars on their property. Both the Traffic Code and the Zoning Code restrict parking.

Code Enforcement defines an inoperable vehicle as a vehicle that has an expired or missing license plate, has broken windows, more than one flat tire, or is obviously missing parts needed for the car to run.

Recommendations for Staying in Compliance

- Keep automobile repair limited to minor repairs
- Keep property free of trash, debris, and auto parts
- Park in designated areas
- Keep grounds and structures clean and tidy
- Cooperate in good faith should you receive a complaint
- Learn and adhere to local zoning and code regulations
