Additional facts:

- More than 100 women have graduated.
- This program is certified by the Supreme Court of Ohio.
- More than 94% of women have been victims of sexual or intimate partner abuse.
- The program now services Franklin County Municipal and Common Pleas courts.

Many women who have been sexualy exploited, been involved in prostitution or have been victims of human trafficking often share one commonality.

Nearly all are victims of trauma.



catch Court is a two-year structured program that connects women with social services, employment, transportation, acceptance, and support, allowing graduates to transition from dependency to freedom.





Services offered through the program include:

- assistance with housing.
- job coaching.
- employee assistance.
- peer support.
- counseling.
- work with a probation solely assigned to help the women in CATCH Court.
- group meetings weekly with Franklin County Municipal Court Judge Jodi L. Thomas.
- and more.
